For most villages, a pub is a vital service; a meeting place to communicate with others and an essential part of village life. The presence of an active pub can greatly develop village community spirit and, it has been said, can help to enhance local property prices.

You may be aware that The Cross Keys has been offered to the village for sale or lease. This kind of venture has been successfully achieved in other communities all over the UK. There are currently 40+ co-operative pubs in the UK and most of these have been set up with the support of the charity Plunkett Foundation. Will our village be the next one?

A small group of locals have set up a steering group to gather information and look at the feasibility of The Cross Keys becoming a community pub.

This is potentially an exciting prospect as the village could build the pub into a real community space offering a variety of services and functions e.g. incorporating our shop and a café.

It would be useful to have your views on the services you would like to see in a village pub and those you would support. Your response will be treated in confidence. It is entirely anonymous, unless you wish to add your name at the end.

The results of this survey, and other information about the pub, will be discussed at a village meeting to be held at the Activities Centre at

7.30pm on Monday 22 May 2017.

At this meeting we will also be addressed by Bernard Lee from Pub is the Hub (a not-for-profit advisory organisation).
