SALE OF THE FREEHOLD OF THE CROSS KEYS

During the early part of the year, it became increasingly obvious that the business model that we were operating at the pub was financially unsustainable. We were in a position where our staff costs were too high in relation to turnover and yet we were short staffed.

A number of different business models were considered and approval to look for a tenant was gained at the special members' meeting on 23rd May 2022.

Since then, we have spoken to a number of prospective tenants, several of which sounded promising initially but ultimately all declined to take the project any further.

However, a prospective tenant declined the tenancy but expressed an interest in the freehold, we continued this dialogue and it has culminated in an offer **of £340,000** to purchase The Cross Keys freehold.

This is significantly more than we paid back in 2017 – and they are in a position to move quickly and would expect to be able to complete about 6 weeks after instruction - if the resolution to sell is passed.

The Management Committee has provisionally accepted this offer subject to a vote at the AGM.

The potential buyers – Ben Davenport and Sam Darling - have a proven track record in the hospitality industry and are currently running a very successful tenancy – The Bull at Troston - and see the next step, as owning a freehold.

They propose to use the same successful business model they're currently using to continue running the Cross Keys as a pub offering both food and drink.

The offer will enable us to repay all loans and debts as well as refunding all share capital. We now have over £50,000 worth of share withdrawal requests which we will be unable to repay with current trading conditions and any new share purchases.

Vote Yes to sell the freehold

- We hope (subject to volunteer availability) to open the pub for drinks only in August with the occasional BBQ and food van
- The pub will close after the August bank holiday Monday V8 Hot Rods Car Show, BBQ, live music and beer festival.
- The pub should then re-open with the new owners later in September (depending upon the time taken for any refurbishment that they may plan)

Vote No to sell the freehold

- Hiring a new Manager and Chef is not financially viable and we cannot find anyone prepared to take on the tenancy.
- Our small group of volunteers will not be able to continue to carry the burden.
- The pub will close indefinitely in either August or September.
